THE **2023 SINGAPORE NATIONAL SCRABBLE® CHAMPIONSHIP** (“the Nationals”) is open to all Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents, and Long-Term Residents. A Long Term-Resident is defined as a person with a permit, pass or other permission from the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority to live in Singapore for at least one year which is valid during the Nationals.

ORGANISERS: The Scrabble Association (SA) is the national body for tournament Scrabble in Singapore. For more information to sign up for membership to be eligible for entry fee discount, and to check your divisional eligibility if you are unsure of your SA rating, visit the SA’s website at <https://www.toucanet.com>.

RULES: The Nationals will be played to World English-Language Scrabble Players Association (WESPA) Rules Version 4.0 ([Game Rules](#)), with a five-point penalty per unsuccessfully challenged word. The word source will be Collins Official SCRABBLE™ Words 2021 (“CSW21”). All games will be rated by the SA.

Registration closes at 23:30 on **21 October 2023** or when we have received 130 paid registrations, whichever comes earlier.

Payment is to be made via Eventbrite. Please ensure that the correct amount is paid; refunds will only be considered in exceptional cases. Please contact the organisers if you require an alternative payment method. Registrations will only be confirmed after payment has been received and acknowledged by the organisers.

The organisers will accept entries on a first come, first served basis and reserve the right to decline entries as they see fit or if capacity is exceeded. The organisers also reserve the right to request proof of eligibility for participation and/or discounts such as residency status and birth dates.

APPENDIX A: PRIZES

All prizes will be in the form of NTUC FairPrice vouchers.

A.1. MAIN PRIZES

The winners of Divisions A and B will also receive the Teck Ghee Challenge Shield and the Douglas Reyes Challenge Shield respectively to keep until the subsequent Nationals, and have their names memorialised on the Shields.

A.2. SIDE PRIZES

Prizes will also be given out for the following categories:

Further details on some of the categories:

Dream Team

This prize is for those that signed up as a team. A team's score is the sum of the 3 best divisional ranks of its members. The team with the lowest score wins the Dream Team prize.

Some calculation examples:

- a team of 4 players with members result of rank 1 in A, rank 3 in A, rank 5 in B and rank 2 in C, will have a score of $1+2+3=6$.
- a team of 5 players with members result of rank 2 in A, rank 7 in A, rank 2 in B, rank 1 in C and rank 10 in C will have a score of $2+2+1=5$.

Overperformer

All players will be given a seeding based on their latest ratings prior to the Nationals. The player who performed the best relative to his/her initial seeding (i.e. ranked the most places above his/her initial seeding) wins the Overperformer award. In the case of a tie, the award will be given to the player playing in the higher division. If there is a tie between players in the same division, the award will be given to the higher-placed player.

However, a player who is eligible for any of the main prizes, e.g. finishes in the Top 5 of Division C, is not eligible for the Overperformer prize, which will then be awarded to the next-best eligible player.

A.3. FIRST-TIME PLAYER (FTP) AND RETURNING PLAYER (RP) PRIZES



Additional prizes are available for first-time players (FTPs) and returning players (RPs), based on the following criteria:

1. FTPs are defined as players for whom the 2023 Nationals is their first SA-rated tournament. They must not have played in any offline SA-rated tournaments prior to the 2023 Nationals.
2. RPs are defined as players who have had tournament experience but who have not played in any offline rated Scrabble tournaments anywhere in the world since **1 January 2020**.
3. To qualify for the “Best Finish” prizes, players must win at least 1 game.
4. There is no requirement to win any games for other prizes such as Oldest FTP/RP.
5. FTPs and RPs are eligible for all other prizes, including main prizes and side prizes.
